As you will know, we have to raise a significant amount of money each year to ensure that the Community Library remains open.

In view of the success of previous year's sponsored walks, we are going again for this year, but with a much more ambitious plan!

Walkers have the choice of either a or b below:

**a) Undertake the entire 33 mile walk in two days, Saturday 6 April and Sunday 7 April.**

Starting at 9.30 on the 6th, target is stages 1 and 2 of the walk (17 miles), Newtown Linford to Mt St Bernard's. Arrival - whenever we get there! Pick up at Mt St Bernards to be taken home.

Starting at 9.30 on the 7th, target is stages 3 and 4 of the walk (16 miles), Oaks in Charnwood to Newtown Linford.

Arrive at Woodhouse Eaves by 12.00 (7 miles to cover) to meet other walkers. Complete the final 9 miles with other walkers

**b) b) Undertake the final stage only (stage 4, 9 miles), Sunday 7 April**

Start at 12.30 at car park in Woodhouse Eaves, finish at car park in Newtown Linford

It promises to be a fun day (or two!), with levels of challenge to suit most people. Please join us and help us to achieve our funding target of £2500.
